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# Motivation

- Transformers are the basic model in machine learning used in recent LLMs

Could you please count the number of "R"s in the word "arbitrary"?

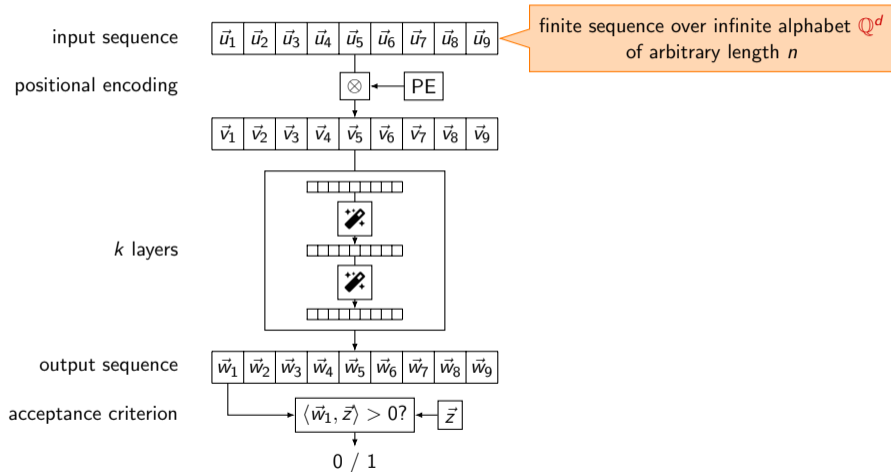


The word "arbitrary" contains **2** "R"s.

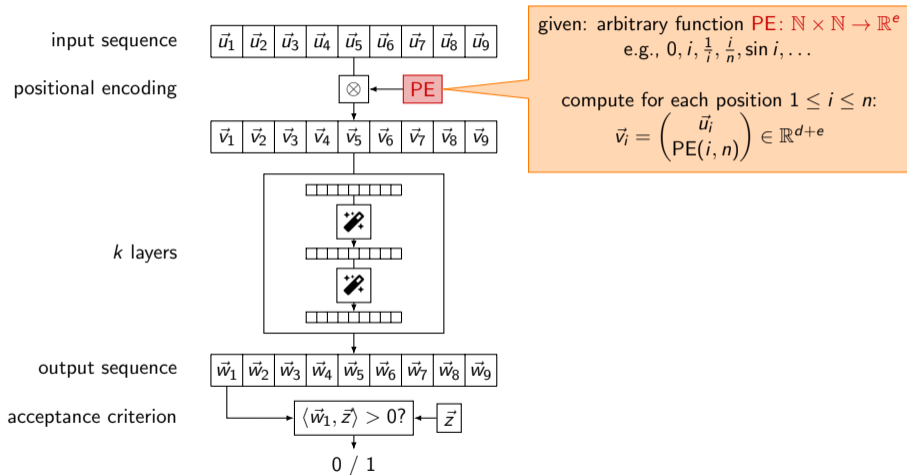
(Spoiler: "arbitrary" contains **three** "R"s)

- Here: we analyze expressibility of transformers that take complex data (like pictures, videos, voice, time series, ...) as input

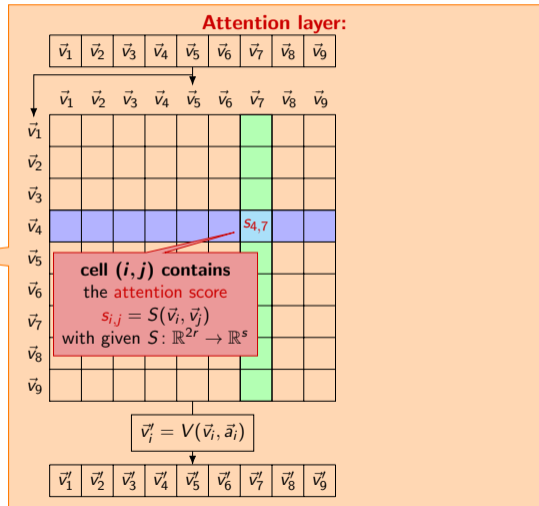
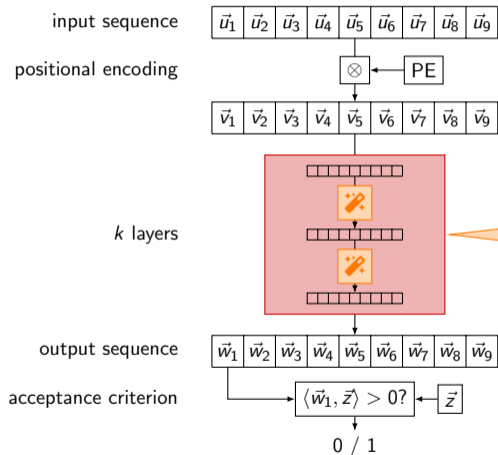

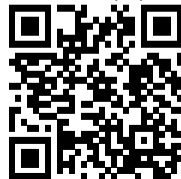

Regularity	$= \text{Star-tree}^*$ [Angluin et al. 2024]	$\not\subseteq \text{Regular}^*$
	$\supseteq \text{LTLTL}$	

Languages accepted by a family of circuits of

- constant depth,
- polynomial size, and
- Boolean gates with unbounded fan-in.

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Regularity	= Star-Free * [Angluin et al. 2024]	AC <sup>0</sup> + majority gates
Logic	= LTL * [Angluin et al. 2024] $\supseteq LTL(\text{Mon})$ [Barceló et al. 2023]	$\supseteq LTLTL$

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# Word vs. Data Languages

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Regular	LTL + monadic predicates $\Theta$ [et al. 2024]	$\not\subseteq Regular^*$
Logic	$= L \vee L^*$ [Angluin et al. 2024] $\supseteq LTL(Mon)$ [Barceló et al. 2023]	$\supseteq LTLTL$

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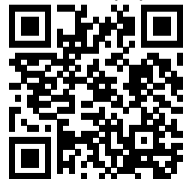
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Regularity	= Sta	<b>Locally Testable LTL = LTL(Mon) + arithmetic constraints</b>
Logic	= LTL* [Angluin et al. 2024] $\supseteq$ LTL(Mon) [Barceló et al. 2023]	$\supseteq$ <b>LTLTL</b>

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
